## Rules and Expectations for the MARK Co-operative

### Student Participation:

Every student will

1. Come prepared for class (homework completed, if applicable)
2. Will participate and follow directions
3. Treat others with respect and courtesy at all times.

If a student is unwilling to abide by these rules, the following action will be taken:

1. 1<sup>st</sup> notice: the student will be taken aside and counseled.
2. 2<sup>nd</sup> notice: the parents will be contacted and asked to intervene.
3. 3<sup>rd</sup> notice: the student will be removed from the co-op with no refund.

### Parental Participation:

1. At least one parent or guardian must remain on-campus with their child(ren) for the duration of the co-op and contribute in one or more of the following ways: teaching or co-teaching a class, assisting in a class, working in the nursery or toddler area. The nature of the co-op is that each family participates to further the education of the whole group.
2. Each family must help with the cleaning of the facility according to schedule.
3. Each family must be willing to contribute to the cost of the facility and supplies for the co-operative. The facility costs are \$25 for H.E.A.T.\* members and \$30 for non-H.E.A.T. members. Class supply fees are in addition to this and will be announced by the teacher of each class. Each family must provide the needed textbook(s) required for the class(es) their child(ren) is/are taking.
